Glenwhan Gardens and Arboretum

Threave Gardens



Take a stroll through the secret garden, rockery and walled garden. At the centre of the estate stands the 19th-century Threave House. The wider estate includes the UK's only bat reserve and an osprey viewing platform.



There is a well-stocked gift shop and plant centre with rare and Threave-grown plants for sale. Make time to enjoy home-made soups and sweet treats in our cafés.

Dog Friendly Walks

Sandgreen Beach

We do however ask that dogs are kept on a lead during busy times (8am – 9pm) this is because the beach can get busy with people doing a range of activities.







Galloway Forest Park


Dog Friendly Walks

Sandgreen to Gatehouse of Fleet Circular

This walk, although a long one, is an easy circular walk starting at the Cally Woods Car Park in Gatehouse of Fleet. This route follows tracks and minor roads through woodlands and the countryside to Sandgreen beach, back through the woods to Cally Gardens returning to Cally Woods.

Distance: 7.75 miles Duration: 3-4 hours
